RULES FOR THE DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE

Please put your garbage out in the designated place of your area by 8:00 a.m. on your collection day.

Find your garbage collection day with the waste collection calendar of your area. See also **Tsu City Waste Sorting Guide** for guidance in sorting your waste.

可燃 Combustible waste

Twice a week

Garbage/Shells

For garbage or other waste containing water, drain any excess liquid before disposal.

Cold gels/Drying agents

Place them in a separate bag to reduce the risk of exothermic reaction.

Place the combustible waste in a transparent or semitransparent bag before disposing of it.

Uncleanable plastic containers/packaging

Rubber products



Cotton futon Feather-filled futon



Tree branches/ Wood

Cut them to about 1 m in length and about 5 cm in diameter, and tie them up in bundles.

Bind the futon with string, place it in a bag, and put it out on the collection day for combustible waste.

びん Bottles

Once a month



Bottles for food and beverages, including alcoholic drinks, juice, health drinks and seasonings

- Rinse all bottles and ensure they are empty.
- Remove all caps of the bottles.
- Metal caps: "Metal/Non-combustible waste," Plastic caps: Plastic Waste

容プラ Plastic containers/packaging

Once a week



All items with the "plastic containers/packaging" logo

Cups/Packs

Cups and packs for pudding, eggs, boxed lunches sold at convenience stores, etc.

Rinse all plastic containers/packaging and ensure they are free of grease, liquid, or food.

Uncleanable plastic containers and packaging must be put out on the collection day for combustible waste.

Bottles Bottles for shampoo, etc.

Plastic cushioning materials Styrene foam cushioning materials used to protect home appliances, etc.

他プラ Other plastic containers/packaging

Once a month

Items without the "plastic containers/packaging" logo

Kerosene containers

Remove kerosene oil.

Helmets

- For small items, place them in a transparent or semitransparent bag before disposing of them.
- If the item cannot be placed in a bag, dispose of it without bags.

Papers Newspapers

Magazines/Miscellaneous paper(Magazines)

Weekly/Monthly magazines Books/Encyclopedias/Paper boxes/Wrapping paper/Copy paper, etc.




Sort by paper item properly and tie them crosswise with string before disposing of them.

Cardboard

Corrugated cardboard

Flatten them and tie them crosswise with string before disposing of them.



Milk cartons

Milk and juice cartons with white interior

Rinse the insides of the cartons, cut them open, dry them completely, and tie them crosswise with string before disposing of them.



For cartons with an aluminum-coated interior, put them out on the collection day for combustible waste.

Clothes/Cloth



Sweaters / T-shirts / Shirts / Sweatshirts / Jeans / Suits / Trousers / Skirts / Kimono

Bed sheets / Blankets, etc. Remove dirt and dry them. Place them in a transparent or semitransparent bag before disposing of them.

Every three months

Dangerous waste: You MUST segregate dangerous waste of different types / categories (e.g. fluorescent lights, dry cell batteries, etc.) with each other.

Fluorescent lights



Place them in the boxes or tubes in which the new lights are packaged so that they won't break, before disposing of them.

Mercury clinical thermometers



Place them in their own dedicated containers so that they won't break, and place them in a transparent or semitransparent bag before disposing of them.

Dry cell batteries



Place them in a transparent or semitransparent bag before disposing of them.

Spray cans, cassette gas cylinders, etc.



You do not need to pierce spray cans or cassette gas cylinders.

Disposable lighters



不燃 Non-combustible waste

Twice a month

Ceramics



- Electric carpets bigger than the size of cushion should be rolled up and tied with string securely.
- Place the broken waste in a transparent or semitransparent bag before disposing of it.

Cosmetic bottles/Disinfectant bottles



Thick/Long Tree branches, Stumps

The size should be as large as 1 person can carry them by him/herself.

金属 Metal

Twice a month

Spring sofas/Spring mattresses



- Battery-operated items must be put out as this category, "Metal/Non-combustible waste" after removing batteries.
- Spring sofas/Spring mattresses/Bicycles..... Attach a notice saying "ゴミ (waste)."
- Heaters/Fan heaters..... Remove any kerosene oil and batteries.



Twice a month

Pet bottles with the PET bottle logo

- Remove the caps and labels of PET bottles.
- Caps and labels: Plastic containers/packaging Waste
- Be sure to empty the PET bottles before disposing of them.




Items NOT Collected by Tsu City

- Items Subject to the Home Appliance Recycling Act "Air conditioners" "TV sets" "Refrigerators/Freezers" "Washing machines/Home dryers"

◆ How to recycle (* Recycling Fee needed)

- Ask collection and transportation operators licensed by Tsu City for pick-up and recycling.
- Bring the unwanted home appliances to the collection site designated by each manufacturer.

- Recycling of Motorcycles

- Recycling of Mobile Phones

◆ How to recycle Mobile phones, PHS phones, rechargeable batteries, and battery chargers are collected at mobile phone stores with a dedicated logo for "Mobile Recycling Network" free of charge, regardless of brand.

(You are also recommended to bring the mobile phone to Eco Stations in the city.)



- Home Medical Care Waste

Injectors, needles and other infectious waste must be returned to the medical institutions. (e.g. Injector needles/Needles of pen-type injectors for self-injection)

- Waste from business activities

- Waste that can NOT be handled by Tsu City Government

- Auto/Motorcycle tires
- Vehicle batteries
- Pianos
- Propane gas cylinders
- Farm equipment
- Oil heaters
- Dangerous drugs/ Agricultural chemicals
- Vehicle oil, etc.

- ◆ How to handle those waste

You are required to consult with the retailers or appropriate disposal professionals.
